What is a Safety Statement?

A Safety Statement contains all of the company's safety rules, risk assessments and procedures. It will also specify exactly how your company will manage health and safety on a day-to-day basis and clearly state who is responsible for safety at the various levels within the company.



Under section 20, of the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act, 2005, all employers including the self-employed must prepare a Safety Statement, which identifies the risks and hazards of the workplace. The Safety Statement must also outline how these Dangers are to be eliminated, controlled or protected in order to ensure a Safe Working Environment. It is the basis on which every Employer (and every self-employed person) must manage the Safety, Health and Welfare of employees, taking account of the various requirements in Health & Safety Legislation.

The aims of the Safety Statement are:

- To involve Management up to the highest level in a clear programme of action
- To stimulate action to ensure compliance with the statutory safety and health provisions
- To identify hazards and to prioritise remedial action which is based on the risk of injury to exposed persons
- To ensure safety measures are kept in place and monitored on a regular basis
- To identify and assign clear responsibilities in relation to safety and health matters
- To ensure systematic follow-up of problems, once identified
- To ensure that resources are assigned to safety and health
- To gain the commitment of all persons in the workplace
